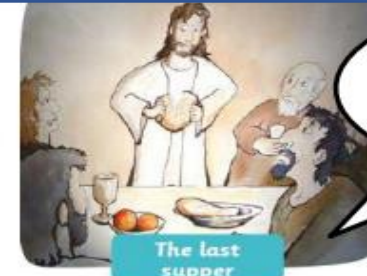
Key Vocabulary
