Different ways to print...

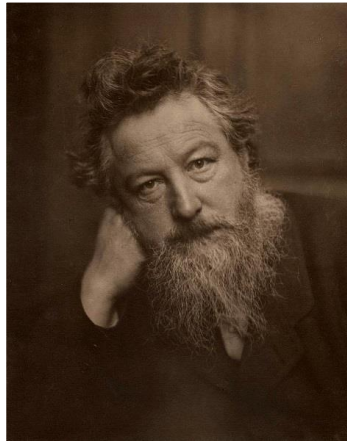
Engraving: Using a sharp tool, artists carve a design into a flat piece of metal.



Woodcut: Artists carve their design into the wood using sharp tools.



Who is famous for using printing?



William Morris was born on 24th March, 1834.

His career in designing started when he decorated his own house in London.

He made patterned wallpaper...

William Morris made designs of floral patterns (patterns inspired by flowers and plants) that could be repeated many times by block printing techniques on large pieces of paper to make patterned wallpaper.
