




## Year 1 Sticky Stuff - History: The Great Fire of London - Summer

<b>bakery</b>	A place that makes bread, cakes, etc.
<b>St Paul's Cathedral</b>	A very large church in London. A new St Paul's Cathedral was built after the fire.
<b>diary</b>	A book that people write about their lives in.
<b>firebreak</b>	A gap that stops a fire spreading to nearby buildings.

### Timeline of events

<p><b>Monday 3rd September 1666</b> The fire gets very close to the Tower of London.</p>	<p><b>Tuesday 4th September 1666</b> <b>St Paul's Cathedral</b> is destroyed by the fire.</p>	
<p><b>Sunday 2nd September 1666</b> The fire starts at 1 a.m. Mid-morning: Samuel Pepys starts to write about the fire in his <b>diary</b>.</p>	<p><b>Wednesday 5th September 1666</b> The wind dies down and the fire spreads more slowly.</p>	<p><b>Thursday 6th September 1666</b> The fire is finally put out. Thousands of people are left homeless.</p>
